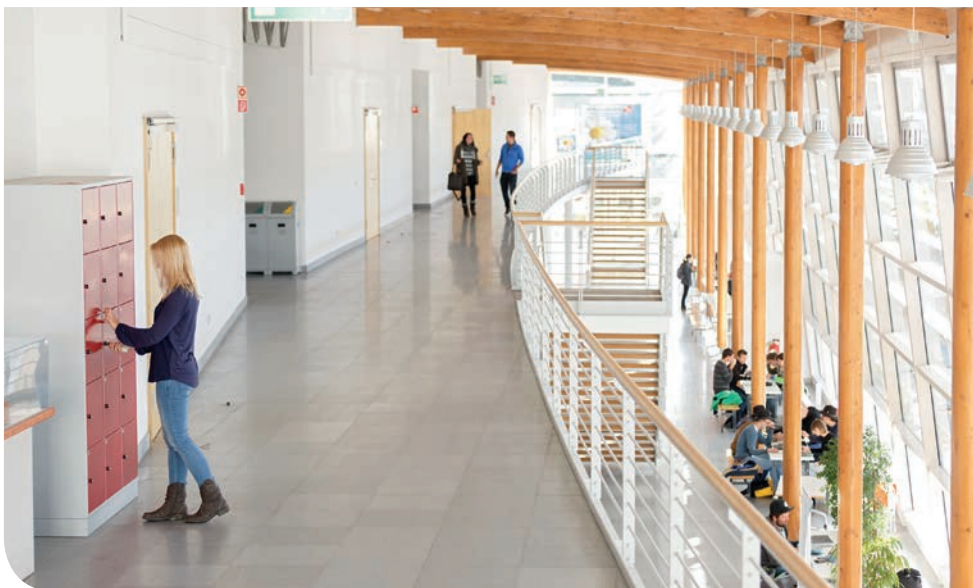

Cost of Living

To calculate your cost of living at TH Rosenheim you need a minimum of about 650 € up to 850 € monthly. In detail find the following basic outline:

	Minimum	Maximum
Rental (student accommodation or private housing)	250 €	400€
Meals	220 €	250€
Health insurance	80 €	80€
Personal expenses	100 €	120€
Total monthly costs	650 €	850€

Note: We collect a Student Union fee of 75 € per semester.

No tuition fees will incur.

Italy, Switzerland and the Czech Republic can also easily be reached on weekend trips.

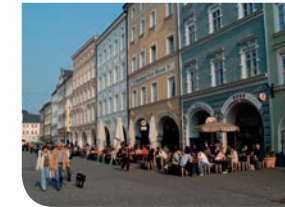

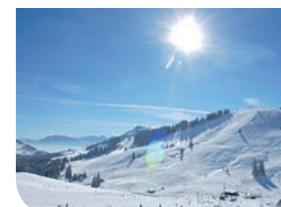
