When:

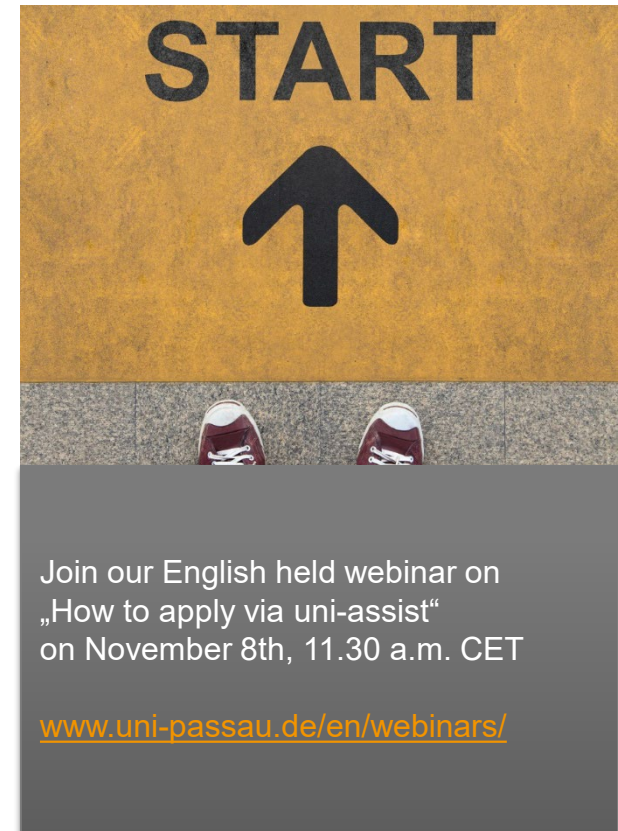
- **application deadlines**
 - 30 June (winter semesters) / 15 January (summer semesters)
- **exceptions: master's programmes of the faculty of computer science and mathematics and Development Studies**
 - 31 May (winter semesters) / 15 Dec. (summer semesters)

Many options, at affordable cost

- State-run student halls (in the city, not on campus):
 - monthly rent: 175 – 335 €
 - apply as early as possible, at the latest by 15 June (winter semester) / 15 Decembre (summer semester)
- Independent & commercial student halls
- Shared accommodation and student flats
 - monthly rent: 180 – 400 €
 - usually require a two/three-month deposit when you move in

How much money will I need?

You should budget for a minimum of €861 per month

- **This amount should cover the following cost:**

rent:	€350-450
groceries:	€150-250
books/other supplies:	€50-100
health insurance:	€80-90

- **Semester contribution (payable twice a year): €84,50**

student services contribution:	€62
semester bus pass:	€22,50

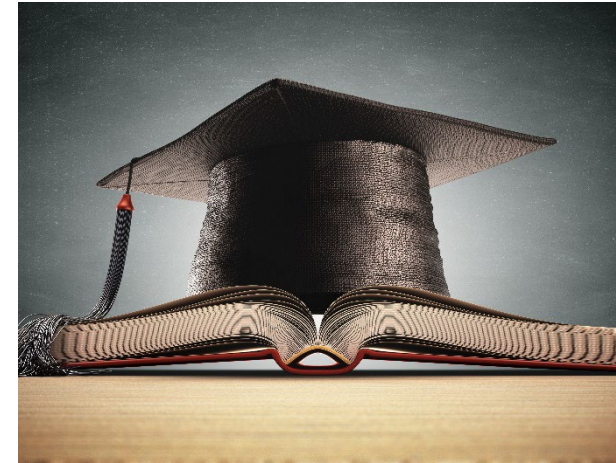
