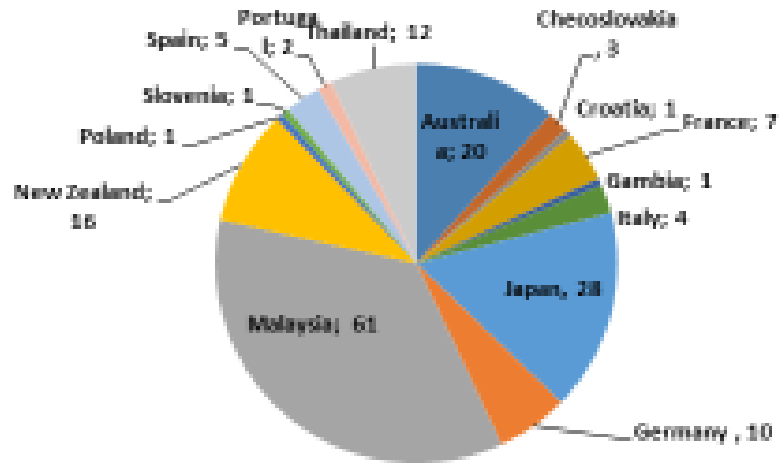

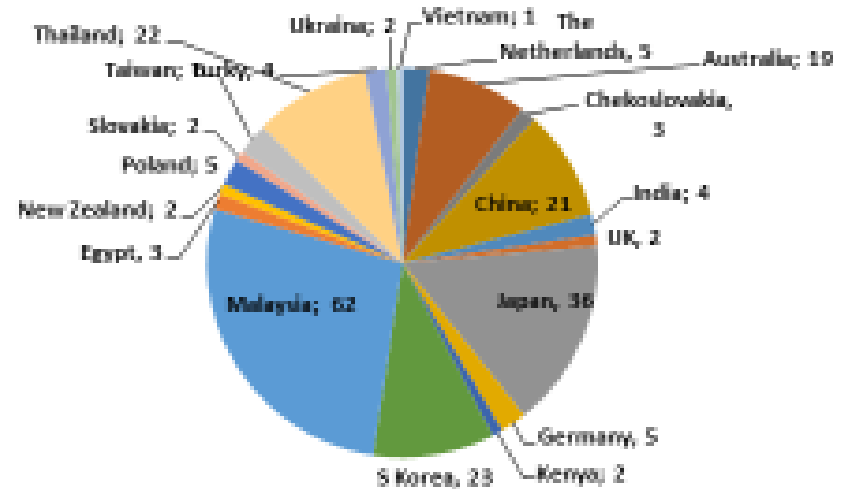
Inbound STUDENTS 2018
